## HTVN Earns Nod from IACET

The application process included a review by an IACET site visitor and a successful demonstration of adherence to the ANSI/IACET 1-2007 Standard – the core of thousands of educational programs worldwide – in the design, development, administration, and evaluation of programming."

The first seminar that HTVN is offering which awards CEUs is Public Housing Manager (PHM). It has been developed and delivered by Nan McKay & Associates (NMA). PHM is \$525 for HTVN subscribers and \$795 for non-subscribers, and is designed for new executive directors, asset managers, and all property managers. In addition to the 2.2 CEUs earned from attending the program, students receive the Master Book, workbook, trainer support, online exam, and a certification.



Three sessions of the program will be held: May 5 to July 16 (registrations accepted until June 18); August 4 to October 8 (registrations accepted until September 10), and October 27 to January 15 (registrations accepted until December 10).
