### SDHC – Housing Our Heroes Initiative About SDHC

- § Established in 1979, SDHC is an award-winning, state-chartered public agency governed by the San Diego City Council, sitting as the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego.
- § SDHC's four major functions:
  - Providing Rental Assistance
  - Creating and Preserving Affordable Housing
  - Workforce and Economic Development
  - Addressing Homelessness



#### SDHC – Housing Our Heroes Initiative HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO Overview

- § HOUSING FIRST SAN DIEGO, SDHC's Homelessness Action Plan, is an effective, diverse funding and housing strategy to create permanent housing opportunities for homeless San Diegans.
- § The first three-years of HOUSING FIRST-SAN DIEGO, launched on November 12, 2014, with a goal to impact the lives of 1,500 homeless individuals.
- § Over the next three fiscal years (2018-2020), SDHC will direct \$79.7 million in Federal, City of San Diego and SDHC resources for six programs to provide permanent housing opportunities for 3,000 homeless San Diegans.





## SDHC – Housing Our Heroes Initiative HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO Programs

#### § **HOUSING FIRST – SAN DIEGO** Programs include:

- New Permanent Supportive Housing: Invest Federal MTW and City of San Diego Affordable Housing Funds to create 500 permanent supportive housing units
- SDHC Moving Home Rapid Rehousing Assistance: Assist approximately
   600 homeless households to obtain and maintain permanent housing
- SDHC Moving On Rental Assistance Program: Rental assistance to 50 formerly homeless individuals who are transitioning out of permanent supportive housing, but continue to need rental assistance
- Homeless Prevention & Diversion Services: Assist up to 1,450 households, which will reduce the inflow of newly homeless individuals and families.
- Coordinated Outreach: Expand support and coordination among existing street outreach efforts.
- Landlord Engagement and Assistance Program (LEAP)





### SDHC – Housing Our Heroes Initiative Program Overview

- § On September 28, 2017, the Housing Our Heroes initiative reached its goal of helping 1,000 homeless Veterans secure housing.
- § Housing Our Heroes included four programs:
  - 1. Landlord Outreach
  - 2. Rapid Rehousing Assistance (RRH)
  - 3. SDHC Federal Veterans Affairs
    Supportive Housing (VASH) Vouchers
  - 4. SDHC Federal Sponsor-Based Housing Vouchers (SBV) with Supportive Services

§ Housing Our Heroes directed up to \$12.5 million over two years in Federal, City and SDHC funds to provide housing opportunities for homeless Veterans.

- Renting to Homeless individuals





#### **Unit Distribution by ZIP Code**














#### **Number Served by Program Type**




